This option allows students to have Office 2007 to use at home so they are working with the same software they use at school. The school has paid the license fee for everyone, but we must still purchase the media (install discs). We are offering the media install discs to families for the very reasonable price of \$10.00. Compared to the store retail price of \$150.00 to \$680.00 (depending on the version) we feel this is a very affordable way for your students to have access to the Microsoft applications used ever day at school.

The Enterprise version of Office 2007 contains Word, Excel, Access, PowerPoint, Publisher, Outlook, OneNote, Groove, InfoPath, Picture Manager, and others.

Some of the system requirements for Office 2007 are:

500 Mhz processor or higher

256 MB RAM min.; 512 recommended; 1GB required for some options.

2 GB of Hard Drive space for complete installation

DVD; CD (but you must let me know as I will have to make them for CD Rom)

Windows XP with SP2 or higher operating system. Will not work with Windows 2000.

1024x768 or higher resolution monitor.
